

Each month there is a Monthly Club Shoot listed. This shoot is for all archers as there is a round suitable for a novice to the most experienced. Every club member is very much encouraged to participate. These monthly club shoots are also used to determine the club champions for the year and the most improved archer.

Club Champions shall be awarded in the following categories provided there are at least 3 archers competing in each category:

- Open Recurve 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Open Compound 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Longbow 1st, 2nd, 3rd

The monthly club shoots shall be used to accumulate points.

Points shall be awarded to archers for scores shot depending on your rating performance against the Archery Australia Classification Tables for your respective division. The points shall be credited as the percentage achieved against your divisions GMB level. As the points are awarded against Classification they take into account automatically a handicap effect for Junior age divisions, for Masters and Veterans, and for gender:

Each year there are generally 12 or so shoots listed in the Club Calendar as Monthly Club shoots.

The total points from an archer's top 6 Monthly Club shoots shall be accumulated to determine the club championship

The Club Recorder shall be responsible for administering the scheme.

Subject to funds being available, trophies shall be awarded to each place getter as the Club Champions for the year.

There may also be a Most Improved Archer award for the archers that have shown the greatest improvement over the year in any single bow type or division, ie calculated on the same bow type and division for that archer.

The Most Improved Archer may be determined from the improvement in average rating achieved for the top 3 scores (from at least 3 scores) submitted in February, March and April to that achieved for the top 3 scores in at least September, October and November for rounds shot at the club shoots at the club as listed in the Club Calendar.
