Participants at the Grange Company of Target Archers are required to follow the following principals and exhibit the following behaviours.

Sanctions may be applied where participants do not follow this code and these sanctions may include exclusion or withdrawal of membership.

Code of Behaviour – Participants

1. Play by the rules.
2. Learn and follow archer's etiquette on the shooting line and while scoring.
3. Never argue with a judge, the Director of Shooting or Field Captain, or other official.
4. Control your temper.
5. Work equally hard for yourself and your team/club. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
6. Be a good sport. Applaud all good performances made by your team/club and the competition.
7. Treat other participants in the sport as you would like to be treated.
8. Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents.
9. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please others.
10. Respect the rights of all other participants.
11. Abide by all Archery Australia, South Queensland Archery Society and Grange Company of Target Archers Policies and follow all club Procedures.
