



Club Membership

This is an Archery Australia affiliated club.

Only Archery Australia members may shoot at the club and casual archery participation by non-members is not permitted.

Membership Fees

Joining fee\$200 (once off is in addition to the annual fee, however the joining fee is waived for those doing an instruction course).

Annual membership fee* (approximate as fees change from time to time)

- Adult (18 and over) \$211
- Youth (under 18) \$152
- Family \$422

Beginners Course\$110 (single Saturday morning) inc GST.

Those on an instruction course must be signed on as a temporary member.

New Membership Enquiries

The club Brochure provides basic information about the club. Please contact the club if you are interested in joining the club. Reference checks may be undertaken before acceptance of membership. Completion of a membership form and collection of a fee does not constitute acceptance of membership, as all applications must be ratified. Existing archers wanting to join but not wanting to do a course must undergo a safety compliance and proficiency assessment by the Club Coach or a designated Archery Coach on a Saturday morning by appointment. Courses are very popular and may be booked out well in advance. We generally take children from 10 and many parents do the courses with their children. Courses teach the basics however people who has been an archer before may find it of benefit. New members are given a Membership Book and undertake an induction. All members must always abide by our codes of behaviour and rules or can face scansions for breaches. Members must always follow the directions of Club Officials. Members need to attend working bees which are called from time to time.
