#### Matters arising from Correspondence:

We have received an apology from the cleaners after the recent difficulties.

#### **General business**

Low numbers have been experienced at the indoor QREs on Wednesday evenings. Difficult to resolve. Air conditioning one of the sheds may assist, the Committee will continue to explore options regarding this. A sustainability grant is coming up at the end of the year, we could apply for solar panels, a battery and perhaps insulation. The potential inclusion of an indoor compound competition at the Olympics may also motivate. An interclub rotational league may not be well attended due to travel requirements in the evening. Suspect attendance will increase as we approach indoor season.

Disability access project is now on pause until we know the results.

Rats have been in the kitchen again. Propose to incorporate closing the door and pull the roller blind down as part of closeup duties. Investigate also a mechanical alternative to the use of poisons.

DOS training may need to be refreshed. Clear the waiting lines on Mid and East fields. Enquiry received for running a program one afternoon for a group of rowers. Currently aren't in a position to pursue this.

#### Other general business

The twelve recommendations from the annual safety audit were discussed. Propose adding a shelf in the corner of the kitchen for tea and coffee and the dishwashing detergents. Two posts and two rails as a single unit would solve the potential trip hazard at the water tank outflow, similar to the main handrailing around the drainage outflow. Putting power into the storage shed is on hold due to potential cost.

Nationals preparation. Pat's Archery is bringing in a container, and he offered to include waterproof faces for us at close to the old rate. Approx \$10,000 for 400x122cm, 100x80cm, 400x80cm/6 ring. We would also purchase paper ones which we would use in preference unless in wet weather. This would be funded by the MBRC grant.
